KENYA MISSION

From October 21–26, our Rwanda team embarked on a journey that marked a transformational milestone for His Hands On Africa. For the first time, they traveled outside of Rwanda, experiencing many “firsts”—first passports, first flights, and first time serving beyond their home country.

In partnership with the Mercy and Love Foundation in Kenya, the team provided care to over 150 patients, bringing not only physical healing but also hope and compassion. This mission trip was life-changing for our team, an experience they will cherish forever.



This milestone is a testament to the incredible growth of HHOA Rwanda. In just four years, we've transitioned from being a mission-receiving organization to a mission-sending one. Praise God for His faithfulness!

HOPE DENAL CENTER UPDATE

We're thrilled to share that construction on the Hope Dental Center (HDC) is making great progress! After months of anticipation, the floor tiles we ordered from India have finally arrived, and they are now being laid throughout the building. This marks a significant milestone for the project!

In addition, work on the warehouse has begun. The second-floor flooring is now complete, and we're finalizing plans for this vital space. The warehouse will include:

First Floor: A multipurpose room/cafeteria (large enough to host over 100 people), a full kitchen, a laundry room, storage, and a staff locker/changing room.

Second Floor: A dental lab and four bedrooms to accommodate short-term volunteers supporting the teaching clinic.

While delays with the tiles temporarily impacted Phase I, we've made the most of the time by advancing Phase II work. Thanks to your continued support and prayers, we're on track to complete construction by May 2025, with an opening ceremony planned for August.
