

Mission Work and Outreach

The Roots Network Outreach

On October 27th and 28th, we held a meaningful collaborative dental outreach, joining forces with two ministries that are active in dental missions in Rwanda. The Roots Network (TRN) contributed with a team of three dentists, a dental supply sales rep from Texas, and a team of pastors to share the gospel with the community. The team from the Dream Medical Center (DMC) supported the effort with two dentists and several assistants and a dental therapist. Joining forces we set out to Gakurazo Health Center, about an hour and a half drive south of Kigali—a community HHOA oversees through our clinic at Nyamata Hospital.



This outreach was more than a convergence of dental expertise; it was a harmonious blend of healthcare and ministry. Gakurazo Health Center, nestled near a ministry of The Roots Network with a flourishing congregation, provided the perfect backdrop for our collaborative efforts. The collective efforts between TRN, DMC, and HHOA is a testament to the unity we have in Christ. TRN's dentists contribute their skills to HHOA, and in return, HHOA and DMC facilitated the community outreach near TRN's area of ministry.



Over the course of two days, our joint team provided dental care to an impressive 415 patients. Simultaneously, the TRN team shared the gospel and offered spiritual care, resulting in 15 individuals accepting Christ as their Lord and Savior.

What makes this partnership truly impactful is TRN's commitment beyond the outreach. With pastors in their ranks, TRN ensures follow-up care for those who were saved, fostering growth as disciples of Jesus.

We believe this collaboration is more than a one-time event; it's a beautiful partnership in the making. As we reflect on the success of

this outreach, we invite you to join us in prayer for God's continued guidance and blessings upon this evolving partnership. Together, we aspire to make a lasting impact on both dental and spiritual health in the communities we serve.

Over the weekend of December 2 – 3, Dr. Lee and his wife Lita were interviewed on the main sanctuary stage of The Church at Rocky Peak by Lead Pastor Michael Yearly! This was a way for the church to hear Dr. Lee and Lita's story as the Church at Rocky Peak's Generosity Initiative was launched with His Hands On Africa as the benefactor.

The goal of the Generosity initiative is to raise \$220,000 for the remodeling, equipping, and launching of the Training Center at the HOPE Dental Center. This will allow HHOA to complete the training



center next year, and focus our fundraising efforts in 2024 to complete other areas of HDC such as – <u>the Sustainability (Private) Clinic</u> and the dental laboratory.
