Local Nonprofit Provides Living Water in Africa!

His Hands On Africa Completes Third Water Well in Rwanda

Chatsworth, CA — August 2, 2023

Chatsworth-based nonprofit His Hands On Africa announces completion of the company's third clean water project in the country of Rwanda. The latest water well blessed the children at Mt Hope Christian Academy, their families, and their neighbors in the village of Karambi. Many Rwandans still obtain their drinking water from polluted rivers which, according to the World Health Organization, can lead to the transmission of diseases such as cholera, dysentery, hepatitis A, typhoid and polio.

His Hands On Africa (HHOA) wants to build a sustainable oral healthcare infrastructure in Rwanda. Their holistic approach to this goal includes increasing the population's access to clean water which helps prevent tooth decay, as well. Cleaning and fixing the teeth of Rwandans will have a longer lasting - and positive - effect if they are also able to drink clean water. It is estimated that each of the three water wells HHOA has built so far will provide clean water for approximately 1,000 families in the area. As they expand throughout Rwanda, more water wells are being planned!

His Hands On Africa (HHOA) is a 501c3 non-profit with U.S. headquarters located in Chatsworth and with operations in Ngeruka, Rwanda. The organization's mission is to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ by providing oral healthcare to Rwandans who would not otherwise have access to dental services. HHOA takes a holistic approach by arranging U.S. dental mission trips to Rwanda, by helping train the next generation of Rwandan dentists, and by building water wells to provide clean water so that Rwanda is not reliant on charitable organizations for their oral health care.
